

## Punctuation Collages

Resources:

A3 paper

Magazines, newspapers etc.

Sissors

Glue

Students are divided in to groups or pairs and allocated a punctuation mark.

Each group/pair is going on a punctuation hunt to see how they are used.

They need to find examples cut them out and stick them on a sheet. They should be encouraged to find as many different ways of using that punctuation mark as possible. Once three or more examples have been found, then students should annotate the cuttings about how that punctuation mark has been used and what the effect is.

**Extension:** students should also be encouraged to write down the rules of using the allotted punctuation mark.

This activity is good for presentations to the class about what each group/pair has found.
