

Reading for Punctuation

Resources:

Class reader

This is a twist on using the normal class reading book or passage and not only reinforces teaching about punctuation marks, but can also help reluctant readers.

Version 1 (teaching full stops)

When reading a text aloud every time there is a full stop then the reader is switched.

Version 2 (teaching full stops and commas)

When reading every time a full stop or comma is reached in the text then the whole class stands or sits. I.e. A full stop is reached – the whole class stands. Next there is a comma, the full class sits and another comma, the whole class stands.

Version 3 (teaching about paragraphs)

When reading every time there is a new paragraph the reader is changed.
