

## Red Light! Green Light!

This punctuation game is a variation on the game Red Light! Green Light!

You need:

- a large space
- A2 or A3 sheets with a full stop, a comma, a question mark and an exclamation mark written on so that students can see the punctuation marks.

In space such as a Hall or playground, pupils should stand a good distance away from the teacher or whoever is "It".

When "Green Light" is shouted the students can move forwards.

When "Yellow light" is shouted, they need to look at it straightaway to see what sign is being held. A sign is held up and the students must immediately obey or go back to the beginning. The winner is the first one to make it across the finish line by following all the punctuation mark traffic commands.

- Comma: slow down and walk
- Exclamation mark: hop and wave your hands
- Question mark: stop, tilt your head, put your hands on your hips and look puzzled.
- Full stop: stop
